We trust you are maintaining adequate safety and precaution during these testing Covid19 pandemic times.

The school seeks to ensure that quality education continues to reach every student even during these difficult times. We are seamlessly integrating classroom teaching with e-learning modes to build a unified learning system. The online classes have received good response from the students. It is good to note that almost all students have availed the facility and attended these classes.

In view of the present exceptional situation, the school has introduced following measures for benefit of its students from Lower KG to class XII.

- There is no hike in the school fees for the current session 2020 - 21. Parents will continue to pay fees as per 2019-20 fee structure.
- The due date for payment of fees for the 1st Quarter has been made flexible and the last date has now been extended till 31st July 2020.
- The late fine has been waived off.
- There will be no bus fee for the 1st Quarter (April to June, 2020)
- 50% of Practical fee has been waived off for the session 2020-21
- Session fee for the session 2020-21 can be paid in 4 equal installments spread over 4 quarters.
- Co-curricular Activity fee can be paid in 4 equal installments spread over 4 quarters.
- Stationery charges will be taken after the reopening of the school.
- There will be an additional reduction of Rs.600/- per month for April, May & June 2020 from the fee payable components.
- Students who have taken admission in the current year and the existing students who have already made payments at higher levels, will be given appropriate adjustments in the subsequent quarters.

You will kindly appreciate, notwithstanding the lockdown, the school continues to incur payment of salary & wages and its day to day expenditure on the upkeep and maintenance of the facilities. Being unaided private school not in receipt of financial support from the government, the school has no avenue other than the fees that it collects from its students (other than the underprivileged belonging to economically weaker section of the society who are entitled to free education under the Right to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009) to manage its finances; and accordingly the school looks up to the parents for their unstinted support.

We trust our association will grow deeper with time. Let us work together to improve the learning experience of your ward.
